Since the first King report in 1994, shareholder activism has been recognised as an integral part of the overall corporate governance ecosystem and increasingly so with the current focus on Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG). Shareholder activism is particularly relevant at present as the Code for Responsible Investing (CRISA) has recently been updated (i.e. CRISA 2).

This four-hour course will give insights to shareholder activism and responsible investing, particularly ESG and sustainability, the legal rights that flow from these, plus best practice corporate governance expectations for investor and investee companies alike. This course will be presented twice in 2024.
